+ Updates in this Release +

The January release brings some new features for the CMS to start the year. This month, Project Merging is available in Volte, and in V3 we have added a multi-select option for workflow so you can publish multiple assets at the same time.

Crownpeak Project Merging

Project Branching was introduced early last year. Since that time, we have added Project Comparison and this month the final piece is revealed with Project Merging. Project Merging is the ability to combine two branched projects to create a new project. This allows you to work on new features and other changes in isolation, then combine them safely to be used in one environment.

Project Merging works as follows:

- Select a branch

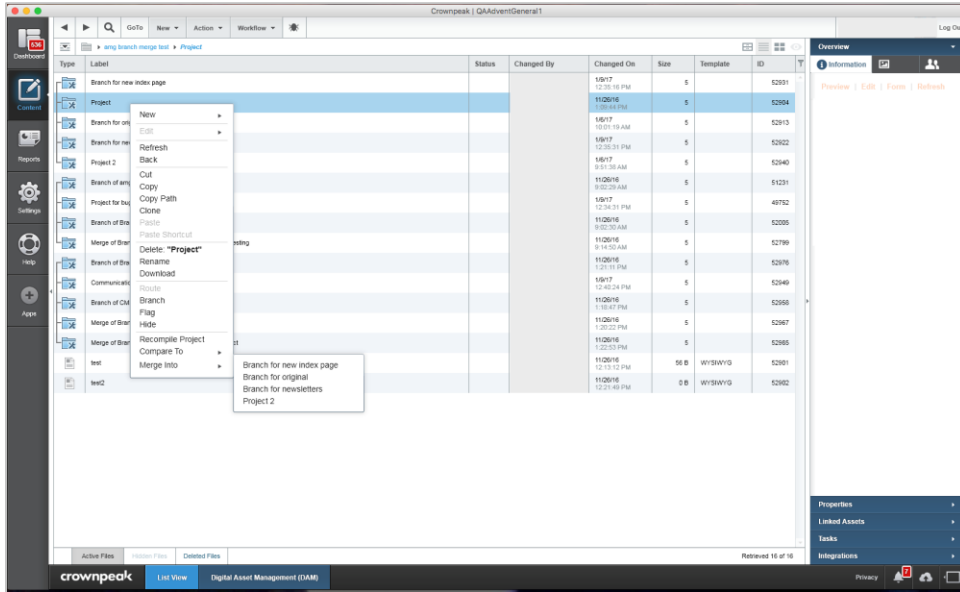


Figure 1 – Project Merge File View

- Select the branch into which you want to merge (Figure 1)

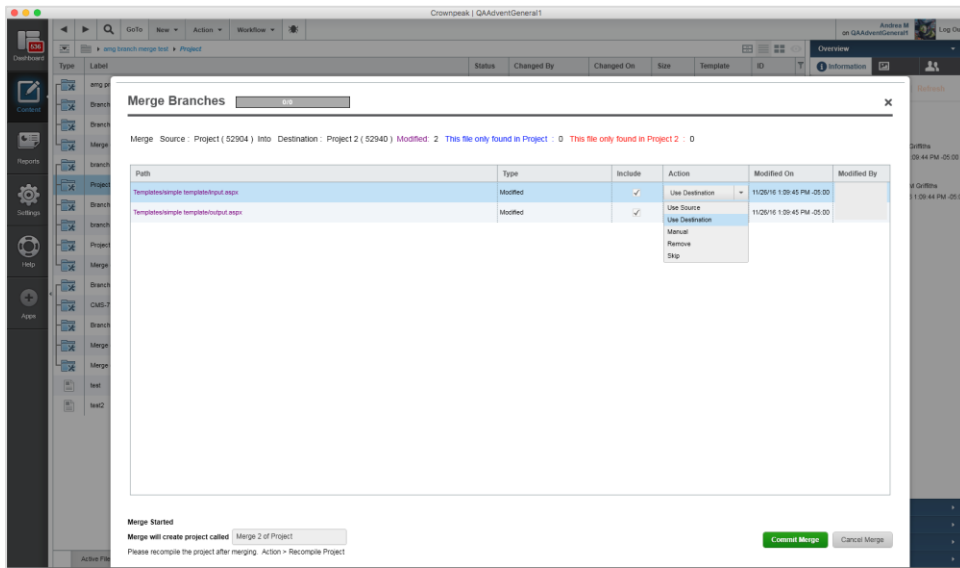


Figure 2 – Project Merge Window

- View the files for merging (Figure 2)
 - Decide if you will include them
 - Select an action (Use Source, Use Destination, Manual, Remove, Skip)
- Complete the merge

The merged branch will now appear in your file list.

Note: You must recompile your merged project branch.

+ V3 Updates +

We start the year off with an administrator feature; allowing asset multi-selection for workflow transitions.

Enhanced Workflow Support

A highly requested feature has been the ability to transition multiple assets from one workflow state (i.e.) Stage, Review, Live to the next allowable state. This capability allows an administrator to quickly and easily move several assets to Live, for example, with a few simple clicks. This will also reduce the need to use the admin level Route feature.

To use this feature:

1. Select multiple assets in File View
Note: All assets must have the same Workflow, and be in the same Workflow State
2. Right Click
3. Select the desired Workflow State

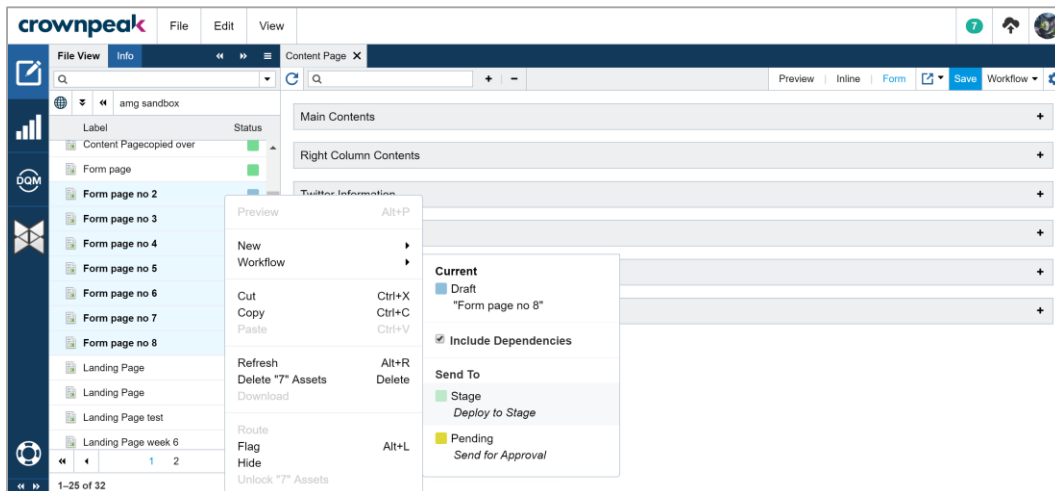


Figure 3 – Multi-Select Move through Workflow

Other New Features This Month

Some of the other new features in this month's V3 UI release include:

1. Input Form View Updates (Alignment refinements)
2. WYSIWYG Updates (Editing Improvements)
3. Asset Upload Improvements (5 Ways to Upload)
 - a. Main Top Menu: **File -> New -> Upload**
 - b. Main Top Menu: **File -> New -> Model** (create your own upload model)
 - c. File View Content Menu: **Right Click -> Edit**
 - d. Main Top Menu: **File -> View -> Form -> Document Selector -> Upload**
 - e. Main Top Menu: **File -> View -> Form -> Image Selector -> Upload**
4. Convert Folder to Site Root (Main Top Menu: **Edit -> Convert to Site Root**)
5. Username on Instance label (**Rollover the user avatar Image**)

6. CMS Marketplace Link (**Last image link in the right menu bar**)
7. Publishing Monitor Details (**Click on the 'Details' link on the publishing monitor**)

2. *Only the applicable Publishing Packages will be displayed for Publishing Refresh (CMS-5650)*
3. *Improved asset creation errors for email import jobs (CMS-7461)*
4. *Publishing Monitor and Long Running tasks will be based on the user's access permissions (CMS-7347)*
5. *Input tabs (when editing an asset) have been restyled (OCD-797)*
6. *Input.ShowAcquireImage respects the ShowUpload flag in V3 (OCD-674)*
7. *Models will appear correctly in the New File list (OCD-656)*
8. *Long filenames will truncate according to window size when using expanded fileview (OCD-813)*
9. *An uploaded user image will display in V3 (OCD-707)*
10. *Report verbiage updated for consistency (OCD-766)*
11. *The DAM panel will sort on Most Recent (OCD-694)*
12. *Several updates were made to alleviate issues caused by disallowing duplicate filenames.*
