This document offers an overview of the product changes in version 1.1.0 as compared to the previous version $1.0.0_13$.

2 NEW AND CHANGED FEATURES

2.1 FirstSpirit module (fsm)

- The content.xml page template has been extended to generate portlet information into the content.xml.
- The content.xml generates the form field information stored in field fs_portal_attribute as <GenericAttribute>
 - o this is relevant for pagesections on pages
 - o this is relevant for portlet configuration parameters
- Pages which have no navigation point, can now contain content and portlets.
- An update mechanism for the module is available, which only changes the page template in the FS project.
- The new parameter RestServiceContext is available for the task StartJBossIntegrationRestService. With this parameter the rest service context assigned to the targeted portal container must be defined.

2.2 JPP module (ear)

Support for non-default and multiple Portal Containers

Until this version only the default portal container with the name "portal" has been supported. Now in the FirstSpirit CMS a new parameter is available, which defines, which REST-Service-Context should be called for the import process in the JBoss Portal. Since for every Portal Container an own REST-Service-Context exists, different Portal Containers can be used as target for the import process.

The content is imported in the default JCR-workspace of the Portal Container.

For all users of the previous versions is a small migration effort necessary. The JNDI name for the database "fsMigrationDB" has to be changed to "fsMigrationDB_<portalContainerName>".
